Position Purpose

The IOI Deputy Leader's role is to support the IOI Team Leader in identifying, training, and mentoring the Australian IOI team annually, as well as supporting the delivery of the Australian Informatics Olympiad program.

The role will involve engagement and attendance at Olympiad events and activities including training schools, team selection and competition events (domestic and international). If the IOI Team Leader is unavailable or unwell for a key duty, the IOI Deputy Leader may be required to act as IOI Team Leader until the normal IOI Team Leader is able to return to duties.

Position Duties

Under the direction and support of the IOI Team Leader:

- Assist in developing and delivering training programs to identify, train, and support students in AMT Informatics Olympiad activities, including the International Olympiad in Informatics program.
- Accompany, supervise, monitor and coordinate the IOI team and staff, including attendance at Training Schools, team announcement ceremonies, and the IOI competition.
- Work closely with the Informatics Problems Committee, EGOI staff, and casual staff to develop and prepare high quality academic content for exams and contests (incl. selection examinations).
- Advise the Selection Committee and IOI Team Leader in the determination of the European Girls Olympiad in Informatics (EGOI) Team
- Help identify suitable staff to support Olympiad activities including tutors, lecturers, problem setters, mentors, live-in staff, and team leaders.
- Other tasks as reasonably directed by the IOI Team Leader, Director Olympiads and Pathways or the CEO.

- Demonstrated passion and enthusiasm for increasing informatics opportunities for young people
- Experience in informatics training and/or teaching, preferably at the secondary/ or tertiary levels or through involvement teaching or participation at Informatics Olympiad training schools

- Strong communication skills both written and verbal
- Excellent organisational and management abilities
