How can your child participate?

Participation is voluntary.

If you wish your child to participate, please give your consent by completing and returning this form to your child's teacher/coordinator. If you do not provide consent, your child will not be able to participate.

If you have given consent, your child's school/education provider will register your child in our online competition management system by providing their first name, last name, year level, and gender (optional).

Privacy Statement

The competitions and programs listed above have been organised by the Australian Maths Trust (AMT), which is bound by the provisions of the Privacy Act 1988 (Privacy Act), including the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) contained in Schedule 1 of that Act. The APPs govern the way the AMT handles personal information. This includes how we collect, use, disclose, and secure personal information.

The personal information provided by or on behalf of the participant, including name and age, is collected to administer the competition or program and the participant's involvement.

AMT will also collect the participant's personal information from the school/education provider.

AMT may disclose personal information to third parties, including the participant's school and teachers and Eljakim Information Technology who operate the competition website for the purposes set out above.





AMT may also prepare reports about its competitions and programs for the Australian Government which may include participant's results, but will not include any names or other identifying information.
